Lead Pastor's Report 2023

In 2023, we viewed the pandemic in our rearview mirror as we moved forward with the opportunities the Lord presented to further our vision. Thanks to the leadership of Pastora Ghie and IWC North, our 6th site was successfully planted in Portage La Prairie in April 2023, with the help of the Guinto family. I had the privilege of speaking during the launching of the site on June 25th. Since then, we have seen a steady increase in attendance. Currently, Pastora Ghie serves as the site pastor for both IWC Portage La Prairie and IWC North. She is actively working to raise a new site pastor to take over at PLP as soon as possible.

Additionally, after eight years, we held another Vision Conference themed "Into the Deep." Pastor Jerry Berenguer of Champion Life Centre was the keynote speaker. He shared his heart and expertise in making disciples and planting churches as the pastor of a multi-site church. Pastor Prime Espiritu of Every Nation also spoke during one of our breakout sessions. Everyone who attended was blessed and inspired to pursue our vision with renewed vigor.

Without any major fundraising efforts, we have surpassed the total revenue of 2022 by more than \$270,000 and are on track to pay off our mortgage by the end of 2025. Running a church of our size and achieving all that we have in 2023 would not have been possible without the dedication of our leaders, staff, and volunteers who faithfully serve at IWC.

I am deeply grateful for the dedicated leadership of our site pastors who are not just partners in ministry but also friends: Pastor Virginia Gonzales and her husband, Jimmy, of North and Portage La Prairie; Pastor Bong Sumayod and his wife, Mina, of Transcona; Pastor Cliff Borres and his wife, Wenie, of Neepawa; and our newly installed pastor for IWC Brandon, Eric Villanueva, and his wife, Grace. Pastoring a site is not an easy calling, that is why they deserve all our love, prayers and support.

The Council members—Pastor Ghie Gonzalez, Pastor Bong Sumayod, Pastor Cliff Borres, Mel Trinidad, Fermel Distajo, and Marie Gravoso—along with myself, have done well in our role to create policies that are aligned with Biblically sound financial stewardship and management of all the resources entrusted to us by God and the members of IWC.

I extend my heartfelt gratitude for the staff's exceptional dedication and service that went above and beyond the call of duty. You have been invaluable companions and teammates in our shared mission of serving God's people and embodying the essence of the church in our community.
