1. Many People Will Be Saved— Read John 3:16-17, Colossians 1:13-14

2.Many Spreading the Good News— Read Mark 16:15, Acts 2:41-47

Jesus commanded all His followers to share His good news with everyone. Despite all the bad news we hear today, Jesus envisioned a growing number of people spreading His Good News of salvation, healing and deliverance.

The early church in the Book of Acts, show rapid and widespread proclamation of the Gospel, amidst persecution. This shows the early church's resilience and the effectiveness of spreading the message of salvation during those times.

Q: Do you sense you have a part in the spreading of the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ? In what way?

3. Many Manifesting the Kingdom—

This means demonstrating His presence through our actions like praying for others, serving others, and living out Christ's teachings. Believers in Jesus are called to show God's power and values through their lives, reflecting His Kingdom on earth. Why?**
